Sunday School is the core of the Student Ministry at Sharon Heights Baptist Church.

Currently, we have coed classes for 6th Grade, 7-8th Grades, 9-10 Grades and 11-12th Grades. We begin with food, fellowship & games followed by a time of praise & worship before breaking out into small groups.

Sometimes it's tough for students to know where to go for answers. The search for truth is very much like the search for treasure. You can dig many places, but unless you are digging in the right place, you will only find fool's gold. Our goal is to lead students to search for truth in the right place, God's Word. It's a time of Christian fellowship and digging into God's Word. It's also a time where students can be open and honest about questions they have or struggles they are facing in the lives.
