## Training

## Extended Session

Extended Session is the time after Sunday school during the morning worship services when families share the responsibility of caring for our preschoolers. Extended session is more than just childcare. Each week a planned activity that shares Bible truths through different media is provided by SHBC volunteers.

- 1st Sunday - Various activities, such as crafts or story time, are lead by Jennifer Bensko.
- 2nd Sunday - Lora Wolch, Cheri Buttram and Alease Cummings supervise 'Flannel Board Story Time'. During this story time, the children help present different Bible stories by placing flannel cut-outs along a scene board, while an adult volunteer reads the story aloud.
- 3rd Sunday - Youth volunteers perform a short puppet skit based on a Bible truth
- 4th Sunday - Mrs. Judy Schaffer and her youth volunteers teach the children new and familiar songs and dance routines.

## MISSION'S NIGHT



Wednesday night is missions night at SHBC. Preschoolers, birth through kindergarten, participate in the Mission Friends group. Mission Friends offers engaging activities for preschoolers to become aware of and involved in missions. In Mission Friends, preschoolers become aware of God's love. They learn that others need to hear about this good news!

Preschoolers are involved in learning, praying, giving and doing missions. Each month, preschoolers learn of a different missionary throughout the world.



At Sharon Heights Baptist Church we want you to feel safe and at home during your worship time with us. We ask that all preschoolers be checked in at the front desk before going to their classrooms. At the check-in desk you will receive matching identification armbands. The child should wear one armband and the adult keeps the other. Only the adult with the matching security armband will be allowed to pick up a child. A pager is also given at the time of check-in. The pager will vibrate to signal that you are needed to return to the preschool area.
